**Step #1- Prepare Seats** 



Remove headrest from mounts and set them aside.

Step #2-Install 50% Backrest



Pull on the strap on the side of the backrest to pull the backrest forward. Place cover over the backrest, matching its contours and cutouts. Tuck in the bottom of the cover towards the back sticking the velcro to the carpet; also tuck in the "X"

Step #3-Install 50% Backrest



Also lift the headrest a bit up, and send the velcro through the headrest. Secure the fit by attaching the velcros together.

Grab the second

onto the carpet.

velcro and stick it



Step #4-Install Cushion



Place the cover on the cushion, matching its contours and cutouts. Tuck in the top of the cover pushing the straps towards the back of the cushion.

Step #5-Install Cushion



Pull up on the front of the cushion, releasing it from its mount. Pull the straps from underneath and buckle them accordingly.

Step #6-Install Cushion



Pull on the straps to fit the cover to the cushion, once it's nicely fitted but the cushion back on its mounts.

Step #7- Install Headrest



Place the cover over the headrest, matching its contours and cutouts. Secure the fit with the elastic.

**Step #8- Finishing Touch** 



Once all covers have been installed adjust the seating and headrests to their regular position. Tuck all straps underneath the seating. Now you are ready to enjoy your CalTrend Seat Covers ©
